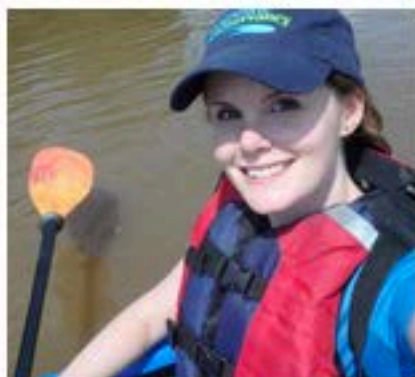
Welcome to our local movement for clean water!

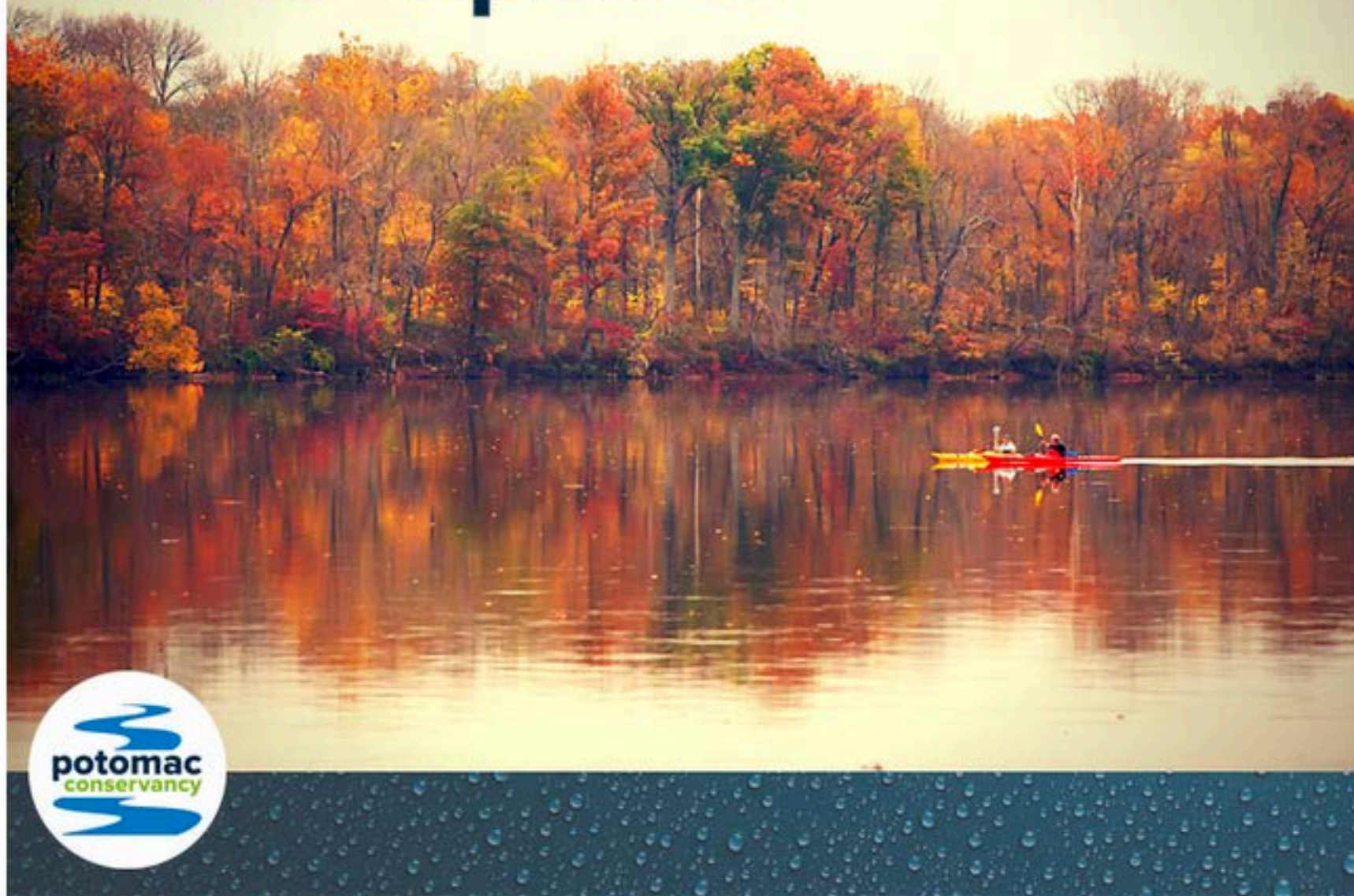
